RULES AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

2008 WASHINGTON YOUTH TOUR ESSAY CONTEST

1. The contest is open to ALL JUNIORS (11th grade students attending high school located within East Central Electric's service area). This includes all or parts of the counties of Tulsa, Okmulgee, Muskogee, Okfuskee, Creek, McIntosh, Wagoner, Lincoln, and Seminole.

2. (a) Write an essay of 500 words or less on the following subject:

“What role does today's youth play in tomorrow's world of energy conservation?”

Use only one side of typing paper. Please double space.

(b) On a separate cover sheet, attached to the essay, include your name, your parents name and address, and your school name and school address.

3. Essays will be judged on the following basis: KNOWLEDGE OF SUBJECT 40%, ORIGINALITY 40%, and COMPOSITION and GRAMMAR 20%.

4. Members of the immediate families of Cooperative employees and Trustees are not eligible to compete in this contest.

5. Entrants DO NOT have to be sons or daughters of East Central Electric members. (Members are on ECE's electric lines.)

6. Winners and alternates will be announced after March 3, 2008.

7. Be sure to have your parents or guardian sign this entry form as indicated.

8. Entrants in this 2008 competition will not be eligible to enter any other REC Washington Youth Tour Essay Contest co-sponsored by any other rural electric cooperative and the Oklahoma Association of Electric Cooperatives.
